



Infants' Acetaminophen Dosing Change

Manufacturers are changing the amount (concentration) of acetaminophen in medicines for infants. These new concentrations will have different dosing directions. During the transition, you may find both concentrations on store shelves and in your home.

What you need to know

- The medicine label for children under two years of age instructs you to call your doctor for dosing directions.
- We can give you the correct dosing instructions once we know the concentration of the acetaminophen in the product you are using.

When giving acetaminophen to infants please remember to always use a measuring spoon or medicine dropper, not a household teaspoon.
